IT is hereby notified that the Council of Land Surveyors, in terms of section 34 of the Land Surveyors Act [*Chapter 27:06*], and with the approval of the Minister of Lands, Agriculture, Fisheries, Water and Rural Development, hereby makes the following rules: —

1. These rules may be cited as the Land Surveyors (General) (Amendment) Rules, 2024 (No.13).
